## NOTICE FOR ELECTIONS

This is further to the notice sent out for the AGM and elections which is due to take place at the P. J. Hindu Gymkhana on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2017 from 7.30 pm onwards.

All those who wish to attend the AGM or / and those contesting the elections or / and voting in the same are requested to adhere to the following guidelines.

- 1. If not an individual member of the BSAM, a letter from bsam affiliated club on its official letterhead signed by either the President or Hon. Secy or Jt. Hon. Secy or CEO/COO, would be required clearly specifying the name of the person who would be attending the meeting or who would cast the vote in the elections on behalf of the Club/Gymkhana.
- 2. Letter from the Club/Gymkhana should reach BSAM either by scanned copy on email id <a href="mailto:bsamah@gmail.com">bsamah@gmail.com</a> or delivered by hand to Mr Sachin Mali or at P. J. Hindu Gymkhana office (Mr Sridhar). Alternatively hard copy can be submitted during the AGM on 30th November.
- 3. Clubs/Gymkhana's or other institutional members whose annual fees are fully **paid upto March 2015** would be allowed to be represented at the AGM or vote for the elections.
- 4. All those who would be voting will need to produce identity proof if asked for. (any one from BSAM membership card, Driving License, Aadhar Card, Passport copy, PAN card or any club membership card which is registered with BSAM and whose subscription fees are paid till March 2015)
- 5. The program for the AGM would be as follows:
  - a. The AGM is scheduled to begin by 7.45 pm
  - b. On conclusion of the AGM the ballot papers for the elections would be handed out. Maximum of 45 minutes would be given to members to collect the ballot papers. Only those members who have collected the ballot papers would be allowed to vote. (This is because the counting and results are to be declared immediately). Voting would commence simultaneously. Further details w.r.t to voting procedure would be given on 30th Nov. by the election officer who conducts the general elections at PJHG and is not a member of BSAM.
  - c. Any individual can cast maximum of 2 votes i.e. one for himself (if member of bsam) & one if nominated by any affiliated club. One person cannot vote for two different clubs.
  - d. All members attending the AGM are requested to avoid undue shouting which may inconvenience the members of the P. J. Hindu Gymkhana.
